 - (a) One RID parent, either the dam or the sire and three RID grandparents
 - (b) No warmblood or foreign bloodlines other than Thoroughbred

I wish to have my mare inspected for registration as an Appendix Irish Draught mare.

I understand that the mare must be presented at an Inspection Centre and that the date and time of inspection will be notified to me when the application has been processed and the mare passed as eligible.

RULES

1. The closing date for receipt of completed application forms is **12 September 2008**.
2. Mares must be two years of age or older to be eligible for inspection.
3. The mares' passport must be presented to the Inspection Team prior to inspection. **FOAL CERTIFICATES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. Mares must have been bloodtyped or DNA typed prior to inspection and in sufficient time to allow for the Bloodtyping/DNA Certificate to be available from Weatherbys Ireland Ltd for the inspection. Bloodtyping/DNA result must be either stamped on the Passport or the Bloodtyping/DNA Certificate enclosed in the Passport.
4. Mares for inspection must be presented in appropriate condition. They should preferably be shown in a bridle. Foals accompanying mares must be led.
5. Where a mare fails on veterinary grounds alone, appeal may be made to the University Veterinary Hospital, Dublin. All costs in respect of such appeals shall be borne by the mare owner.
