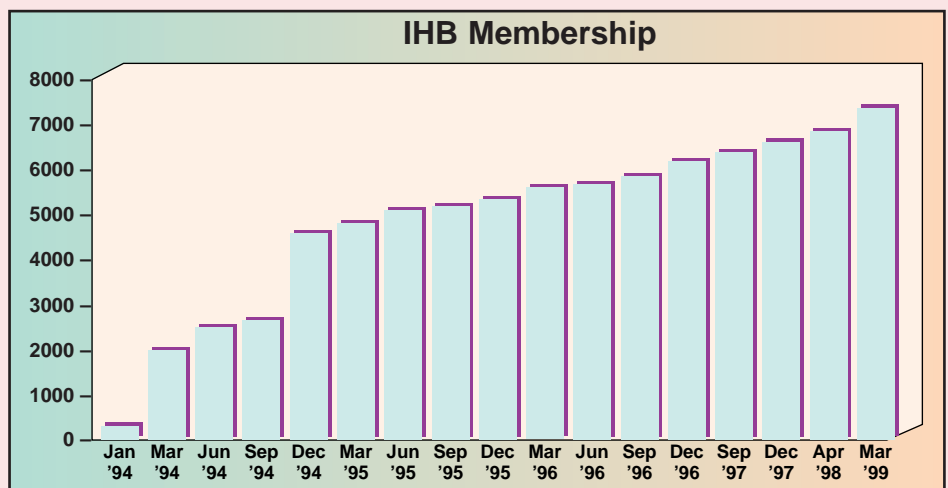

Stallion Inspections, 1999

Inspection of stallions for classification in the Irish Horse Register will be held in late March at regional centres. The application fee is £150. The application form includes a pre-inspection veterinary report form which is completed by the applicants veterinary surgeon. As part of the inspection procedure, each stallion is fully vetted at the inspections and blood samples are taken for analysis for prohibited substances. The inspection panel for sport horses and thoroughbreds consists of three people. The panel is expanded to five for Irish Draughts, incorporating two representatives from the Irish Draught Horse Society.

Stallions are classified into Approved, Supplementary 1 or Supplementary 2. Sport Horses and Irish Draughts are required to undergo performance testing either in open competition or in central testing. Full details are outlined in the publication entitled "Supplementary Stallion List". Performance testing is grant-aided under the OPARDF; a grant of £2000 is payable, towards the cost of performance testing in open competition, and £1750 for central testing.

On completing of performance testing, stallions are inspected at the Autumn inspections. A total of 19 stallions were approved following the 1998 Autumn inspections for performance tested stallions. The results are in Annex 1.

Mare Inspections

The Quality Broodmare Retention Scheme:

A total of 1297 mares were selected for this scheme in 1995-1997. The selected mares are eligible for grants of £1000 under the OPARDF, i.e. £500 in respect of each of two foals registered in accordance with the rules of the scheme.

The Premier Broodmare Scheme:

This scheme was introduced in Autumn 1998. Under this scheme, mares in the main studbook are inspected for the awarding of "Premier" status. Grant aid is not available for this scheme. A total of 127 mares were inspected in Autumn 1998, and 86 (67.7%) were accepted (details are enclosed in Annex II). Inspections will take place in late April/early May 1999 and also in the Autumn. The inspection fee is £30. An application form is enclosed.

Elections to the Board

Elections will be held in Regions 1, 3 and 5 in 1999 (the seats of Ms Mary McCann, Mr Tim Holland and Mr Michael Duignan). Shareholders in those regions will be invited (in April) to nominate candidates for election and postal elections will be held in May. The current Board is as follows:

The publication "Foals Registered in 1998" will be circulated to shareholders who have paid their 1999 annual membership fee.

Fees for 1999

Foal/ Adult registration fees for shareholders who pay their annual membership fee for 1999 are as follows (no increase from 1998):

- ◆ Foal Registration£25
- ◆ Adult registration of horses which have an IHR foal identification certificate£15
- ◆ Naming of horses which have an IHR passport that was issued at the foal stage since 1995...£15
- ◆ Passports without pedigree.....£25
- ◆ Endorsements of passports or identification documents from other studbooks, or the issuing of passports in respect of the latter ...£25
- ◆ Issue of replacement passports.....£25

These fees will be increased by £20 where the annual membership is not paid.

Annual Membership Fee, 1999

The annual membership (£10) form has been sent to each shareholder. It is necessary to pay the membership fee to remain on the mailing list, and to receive complimentary copies of stallion books, the foal book and other publications.

The income sources of the IHB for 1999 are as follows:

- ◆ income from registration fees and membership fees, estimated at £250,000;
- ◆ grant of £150,000 from the Department of Agriculture and Food (increased from £75,000);
- ◆ a grant of up to £100,000 from the Department of Agriculture and Food towards the cost of the Inward Buyer Programme;
- ◆ EU Structural funds;

The 1998 audited accounts will be circulated to shareholders in April '99.

Covering Mares: Mare owners should bring the mares passport to the stallion owner to record the mares IHR number onto the covering certificate. Mare owners can obtain a copy of the covering certificate (made out in triplicate) from the stallion owner.

Covering Certificates: Stallion owners should send in the 1998 covering certificates to facilitate the issuing of Foal Return Forms to mare owners. Covering certificates should have been sent in by the end of October 1998.

Naming your horse - Prefix

Application forms for registration of a prefix were circulated to shareholders in 1998, and almost 500 breeders registered a prefix. Application forms can still be obtained from the IHB.

Training of Riders

Eventing: The IHB provided £10,000 to the IHTS in 1998, which was matched by £10,000 from the IHTS, to fund a training programme for promising riders. The IHTS engaged the services of a trainer to provide central training sessions, and to travel to the European Championships with the teams.

This programme, which is overseen by the training committee of the IHTS, is being extended in 1999. The IHTS circulated its members with regard to applications etc.

Showjumping: The SJA and the IHB jointly funded training for four riders in establishments overseas. The IHB has allocated funds for this programme for 1999 also.

Dressage: Dressage Ireland and the IHB are jointly funding central training whereby top European trainers give training and run clinics in Ireland for selected riders. The first of these training sessions was held in November 1998, and the programme will be continued in 1999.

PRESS RELEASES

The IHB issued in excess of thirty press releases to equestrian journalists worldwide in 1998, outlining the recent achievements of Irish Sport Horses. Copies of the press releases are available from the IHB.

Badminton, the most prestigious three day event in the world was won by Irish Sport Horses in 1998, 1997 and 1995.

The 1998 winner, **Word Perfect II**, was bred by Ms Myrtle Crozier, 52 Mowhan Road, Markethill, Co Armagh.

The 1997 winner, **Custom Made**, was bred by Mrs Kitty Horgan, Glenview House, Bandon, Co Cork and her daughter Mrs Elizabeth O'Flynn Rinnwood House, Oranmore, Co Galway.

The 1995 winner, **Eagle Lion**, was bred by Mrs Patricia Nicholson, Barfordstown Stud, Kells, Co Meath.

Word Perfect II, 1988 gelding, by Lexicon (TB), out of Bessie Ash (ISH) by Nordeline (TB), ridden by Christopher Bartle (GB). The main achievements of "Word Perfect II" to date include:

- 1996 - 5th Bramham CCI***.

"Stream Lion" is also the dam of two other international eventers, viz., "Pirate Lion", by Patch (TB), individual bronze medalist at the World Championships 1990, fourth at Lexington CCI*** 1990, and "Regent Lion", by Horos (TB), second at Lexington CCI*** 1994, second at Radnor CCI** 1990.

Expenditure of EU Structural Funds

Nine schemes are in operation under the OPARDF, 1995–1999, as follows:

Quality Broodmare Retention Scheme: A total of 1297 mares were accepted for this scheme, qualifying for grants of £1000 (£500 X 2) in respect of two foals, by approved stallions, registered in accordance with the rules of the scheme. A total of £510,000 was expended up to the end of 1998, as follows: £1000 per mare has been paid in respect of 215 mares, and £500 per mare has been paid in respect of a further 590 mares. A sum of £541,000 is available to meet payments under this scheme for 1999, which is sufficient to provide for eligible foals born/registered in 1999.

Farriery: The £200,000 allocated to this project will be spent in 1999, when the Racing Apprenticeship Centre for Education develops the farriery training unit, under the control of the Irish Farriery Authority.

Artificial Breeding Techniques: A sum of £246,000 was allocated to this scheme. From a total of 33 applicants, 11 were selected by the Department of Agriculture and Food for grant aid for the development/enhancement of equine AI facilities. The work is progressing at present on these projects.

The money allocated to the other 6 schemes amounts to £2.14M. The expenditure up to the end of 1998, and the amount of money available for 1999 is as follows:

* Funds may be transferred between schemes to meet requirements/priorities.

Promotion and Marketing: The funds allocated for this scheme are disbursed as follows:

- ◆ exhibits at shows and purchase of exhibits materials for the IHB, breed societies and other equestrian organisations;
- ◆ publication of brochures, stallion book, foal registration book etc, for the IHB and other Breed Societies;
- ◆ advertising achievements of Irish Sport Horses;
- ◆ studbook competitions involving payments to the SJAI, IHTS and ISA;
- ◆ computer facilities for various equestrian organisations;
- ◆ stallion shows for approved stallions;

Studbook Establishment and Development: Funds have been used for the computer facilities of the Irish Horse Register, the Connemara Pony Breeders Society, the Irish Pony Society and the Irish Draught Horse Society.

Quality Stallion Purchase Incentive Scheme: The purchase of 18 stallions has been grant aided under this scheme to date.

Random Bloodtyping Scheme: Under this scheme, a random sample of approx. 15% of foals, registered in the IHR are bloodtyped to verify pedigree. The scheme also applies to foals registered by the Connemara Pony Breeders Society.

Stallion Performance Testing: To date, a total of 77 stallions have been selected for grant aid under this scheme, for performance testing for approval in the IHR. Grants have been paid in respect of 64 of these to date. Payments have also been made to the Connemara Pony Breeders Society for stallion performance testing.

Genetic Indexing: Expenditure under this scheme involved:

- payment to University College, Dublin, for further development of the system, and to analyse the data;
- provision of computer facilities for the SJAI and the IHTS;
- payments to the SJAI for data input.

The Inward Buyer Programme

Under this programme, the cost of an air ticket (apex rate), or the equivalent for a ferry, is refunded to buyers of horses and ponies for export from Ireland. The programme is jointly funded by the IHB and the Department of Agriculture and Food in the ratio 1:2, respectively, and it is advertised in equestrian magazines worldwide.

The Inward Buyer Programme operates at the auction sales companies and at the main international shows (private sales).

WBFSh - Studbook Competition at Le Lion d'Angers (Fra)

Teams representing studbooks compete at this event in October, in conjunction with the World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses (WBFSh). The IHB has allocated £500 per horse for a team to represent the Irish Sport Horse studbook, to be paid via the IHTS. The criteria for eligibility are as follows:

- ◆ horses of 6 and 7 years of age;
- ◆ horses must be in the main studbook section of the IHR, with sire (approved) and dam documented.

The IHB will also provide up to £200 per horse for training. Horses will be selected by the IHTS, and preference will be given to horses that have completed a two star event.

Details are contained in the IHTS Spring/Summer schedule.

The Irish Sport Horse Studbook competitions will be held at Cavan Equestrian Centre over three days, 3, 4, 5 Sept. 1999, for 5, 6 and 7 year olds, plus a class for approved stallions. Details will be published in the SJAI bulletins. Teams of 5, 6 and 7 year olds will compete at the World Championships for Young horses at Lanaken (Belgium) in September (23-26). It is expected that the ISH studbook will be allocated five entries for Lanaken in the above age categories.

The SJAI receives financial assistance from the IHB under the OPARDF towards the overhead costs of running these competitions. Travel grants of £1,200 are payable to owners of horse sent to Lanaken from Ireland

The teams of 5 and 6 year olds will be as follows: the top 4 placed in the final at Cavan, plus a fifth horse to be selected

from those that compete at Cavan. In relation to the seven year olds, the top two in the final will be invited to compete at Lanaken, and three other seven year olds may be selected.

Wild cards are also given by the organisers at Lanaken to accommodate horses based outside of their country of birth. Accordingly, the owners of Irish Sport Horses located outside of Ireland may apply to the show organisers at Lanaken.

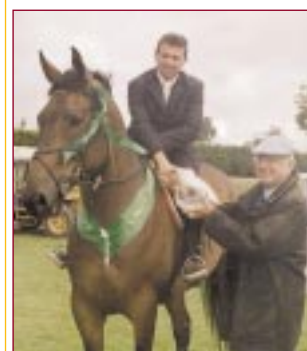

The International Breeding Guide for 1998/99 published by the World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses provides a list of leading breeders of international horses in the world in competition for the years 1991/98. Mrs. Patricia Nicholson, Barfordstown Stud, Kells, Co. Meath is listed as the top breeder in eventing, and Mrs. Mary Hughes (deceased), Kilmanahan, Dungaravan, Kilmacthomas Co. Kilkenny is ranked second top breeder of showjumpers.



Regent Lion

Mrs. Nicholson bred "Eagle Lion" (by Gipfel, TB), "Pirate Lion" (by Patch, TB), and "Regent Lion" (by Horos, TB), all out of Stream Lion (ISH), by Ideal Water (ISH). The three horses were ridden by Bruce Davidson (USA). "Eagle Lion" won Badminton CCI**** in 1995 and was placed 3rd, 4th and 8th there in 1998, 1994 and 1997, respectively. He won at Fair Hill CCI*** in 1992 and was placed third there in 1996. He was fourth at Burghley CCI*** in 1993. "Pirate Lion" won the individual bronze medal at the World Championships in 1990 and was fourth at Lexington CCI*** 1990.



Pacific Lion

"Regent Lion" was second at Lexington CCI*** in 1994, and was second at Radnor CCI** in 1990.

"Pacific Lion", by Ideal Water (ISH) out of "Kilmoganny" (ISH), by King of Diamonds (RID), rider Ms Melissa Ranshausen (USA), won team silver at the Pan-American Games, 1995, and was placed 2nd and 3rd at Fairhill CCI*** in 1994 and 1992, respectively.

Mrs. Mary Hughes bred "Vivaldi" (by Imperius, TB, dam by Water Serpent, ISH), "Special Envoy" (by King of Diamonds, RID, dam by Highland Flight, TB), and "Diamond Exchange" (by Diamond Serpent, ISH, dam by Artic Que, TB). 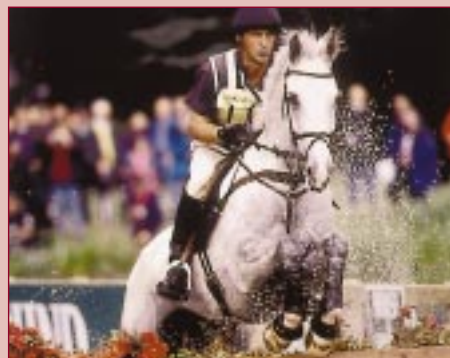
